The Town of Marana and Granite Construction are continuing construction to improve Silverbell Road from Ina Road to Cortaro Road. Please be aware of the following traffic restrictions:

- **Silverbell Road continues to be completely closed from Bradstreet Drive to Ina Road until November 1, 2008.**
- **Silverbell Road, from Cortaro Road to Bradstreet Drive, will be open to local and library traffic only.**
- **The Wheeler Taft Abbett, Sr. Branch Library will be open on June 7, 2008 and can be accessed by traveling south on Silverbell Road from Cortaro Road and then east on Schisler Drive.**

This project includes reconstructing Silverbell Road to five lanes from approximately 700 feet south of Cortaro Road to Ina Road. A new traffic signal will be installed at the Silverbell Road/Ina Road intersection. Other work consists of the installation of a new sewer mainline, water line replacement and major drainage improvements. Silverbell Road will be closed until November 2008, however other work such as landscaping and artwork will occur after the road opens. The entire project will be complete in early 2009.
