Silverbell Road Open Friday Night October 31

The Town of Marana and Granite Construction are making progress on the Silverbell Road, Ina Road to Cortaro Road roadway improvement project. **As promised, Silverbell Road will be open by November 1.** Please be aware of the following traffic changes and restrictions:

- On Friday night, October 31, 2008, Silverbell Road from Bradstreet Drive to Ina Road will open to traffic. One travel lane in each direction will be available for use.
- Traffic signal changes will occur at the intersection of Silverbell Road and Cortaro Road to accommodate for the increased northbound traffic flows. <u>Please pay particular</u> attention to these traffic control changes.
- The speed limit will be reduced to 25 MPH.
- There will be no pedestrian access on Silverbell Road at this time.
- Bicyclists need to be cautious and travel in the travel lane with motorists. The bicycle lanes are not completed at this time.
- Construction crews will still be present working to complete the additional travel lanes, bicycle lanes, medians, landscaping, and sidewalks.
- Please proceed with caution, obey the posted speed limit signs and be alert for construction equipment and personnel.
