The Citizen's Police Academy is designed to give people who live and work in Marana the opportunity to get to know their Police Department. The goal of the Academy is to further our partnership with the community. Participants in the academy will learn about the police department's role in the community and the criminal justice system. The instruction is informative and a variety of topics are covered each week. Marana Police Department personnel provide the instruction which will give the participants an opportunity to get to know the officers, civilian employees, and specialty units.

The Academy is a thirty hour block of instruction consisting of ten classes which are held once a week from 6:00 pm until 9:30 pm.

Attendees are eligible to receive college credit upon completion of this program at no cost to the attendee. Registration for college credits will be completed during the class.
