# Pool Committee Meeting Windmill Park – November 1, 2010 at 7:00 P.M. Minutes

- I. Call to order 7:02 P.M.
- **II. Roll Call** Committee members Barbara Kochel, Chuck Valade, and Kermit McCutchan were present, as well as Board liaison Peggy Bracken and management representative Josh Seng.
- III. Elect New Committee Officers Motion to appoint Chuck Valade as CRCA Pool Committee Chairperson (Kochel/McCutchan). Unanimously approved.
- **IV. Guests –** Clyde Woods, of Oasis Pool Service, provided information on pool filter equipment and pool plaster maintenance.
- V. November 1, 2010 Agenda, with the addition of items X.–C,D,E, was approved by motion (Kochel/Valade). Unanimously approved.
- VI. October 4, 2010 Minutes was approved by motion (Kochel/Valade). Unanimously approved.
- **VII. Board Actions** 
  - a) October 6, 2010 None

#### **VIII. Management Report**

- a. Pool Furniture Replacement Committee reviewed budget for scheduled annual furniture replacement and replacement costs from furniture supply company. Motion to recommend to the Board to purchase nineteen (19) sitting chairs and ten (10) chaise lounges from Sundrella at a cost NTE the budget amount of \$5,070 (Valade/McCutchan). Unanimously approved.
- b. Handicap Access Regulations Mr. Seng presented the ADA federal guidelines.

#### IX. Unfinished Business

- a. Windmill Deck Resurface/Repair Mr. Seng reported that he is gathering bids.
- b. Windmill Restroom Hand-dryers At the request of the Committee, Mr. Seng presented the bid from Pro-Care Janitorial for the purchase and installation of electric hand drying units for the men's &women's Windmill Park Restrooms. Motion to recommend to the Board to accept the proposal from Pro-Care Janitorial installation of electric hand drying units for the men's &women's Windmill Park Restrooms at a cost NTE \$958.00 plus tax. (Valade/Kochel). Unanimously approved.
- c. Pool Perimeter Fencing Replacement Mr. Seng presented three bid proposals for perimeter fence replacement at Community Center and Windmill Park pools. Motion to recommend to the Board to accept the proposal from Antech Corporation for replacement of the perimeter fences at the Community Center and Windmill Park pools at a combined total NTE \$32,631.27 and in a tan color finish (Valade/McCutchan). Unanimously approved.

### X. New Business

- **a.** Community Center Wall Repair Mr. Seng presented three proposals. Committee making further review for discussion at the December Pool Committee meeting.
- **b.** Food & Beverage Regulations At the request of the Board, the Pool Committee discussed possible methods of enforcing the food and beverage rules at the pools.
- c. Kiddie Pool Plaster After hearing a theoretical solution, from Mr. Woods, to the plaster discoloration in the Windmill Park pool and Community Center kiddie pool, the Committee requested a proposal from Oasis to test the "sequestering" method on the kiddie pool. If the application is effective, they will research using it on the Windmill Park pool
- **d. Heater Bypass Valves Motion** to replace the heater bypass valves at the Windmill Park pool. (Valade/McCutchan). Unanimously approved.
- e. Cyclone Pre-filter Component The Committee requested that management research and estimate dollar savings based off the estimate from Oasis on gallons of water saved by installing the Cyclone pre-filter components.
