Join us in celebrating the completion of the Town of Marana and the Regional Transportation Authority's first major roadway corridors — Twin Peaks Interchange and Twin Peaks Road (Camino de Mañana).

These milestone projects are intended to connect our growing communities, provide easier access to Interstate 10, reduce travel time, ease congestion and increase traveler safety.

Strong partnerships among contractors and jurisdictions have yielded two outstanding transportation projects that will provide improved regional mobility and enhance our quality of life today and into the future.

Celebrate the completion of the Twin Peaks Interchange and Roadway (Camino de Mañana).



The Camino de Mañana project (Twin Peaks Road) has realigned and connected 3.3 miles of roadway from the Twin Peaks Interchange to the intersection of Tangerine Road and Dove Mountain Boulevard.



The new Twin Peaks Interchange included the construction of bridges over I-10, Union Pacific Railroad and the Santa Cruz River. This project also improved drainage, and roadway conditions along Twin Peaks and Silverbell Roads.
