**III. October 8, 2012 Meeting Agenda** – approved by motion as amended, adding items IX-B and IX-C under New Business (J. Lambert/ Gilhuys).

IV. September 4, 2012 Meeting Minutes - approved by motion (J. Lambert/Gilhuys).

#### V. Guests:

- A. Don Mady, Regional Manager and Ruben Arrieta Superintendent of DLC Resources
  - i. Mr. Arietta presented the monthly activity report

#### VI. Board Actions

- A. September 20, 2012
  - i. CONSENT AGENDA: DLC proposes a single pesticide treatment of all 148 Agave plants throughout CRCA at a cost not to exceed \$1,585.07. Budget code 83005. DLC also proposes to fertilize the eight queen palm trees with palm fertilizer, in three seasonal applications, at a cost not to exceed \$322.17.
  - ii. MISCELLANEOUS PLANT REPLACEMENT: MOTION made/seconded (Lambert/DeLarge) to accept proposal from DLC to install 89 five-gallon replacement plants throughout the community at cost not to exceed \$1,958.00. Unanimously approved.
  - **iii. MOTION** made/seconded (DeLarge/Stimpson) to accept proposal from DLC to install 18 15-gallon Little Johns (9 on each side) at Coachline and Silverbell monuments at cost not to exceed \$1,710.00. Unanimously approved.

## VII. Management Report

- **A. Mesquite Tree Windmill Park** Mr. Seng presented a photo of the mesquite tree at the far west end of the Windmill Park field, noting the large section hanging low to the ground. Committee directed DLC to remove low-hanging portion.
- **B.** Agaves in Parcel 15-c Mr. Seng reported two agaves had sent up their stalks. Committee noted that they should be replaced. DLC to attempt to replace with pups at no cost.

### VIII. Unfinished Business

- **A.** Future Projects The Committee noted the preferred areas for annual granite replenishment to be researched for next meeting; north end of Coachline Blvd and Western section of Twin Peaks Road.
- B. Twin Peaks/Coachline Enhancement Motion to recommend to the Board to accept the proposal from DLC Resources for enhancement of the N.E. & S.W. corners of the intersection at Twin Peaks Road and Coachline Blvd; plantings and irrigation at a cost NTE \$1,500 (N. Lambert/ Gilhuys). Unanimously approved.

C. Parcel 16 Tot Lot Restoration (Veridan/Yellow Moon) – Motion to recommend to the Board to accept the proposal from DLC Resources for restoration of landscaping at the Parcel 16 tot-lot, plantings and irrigation at a cost NTE \$3,500 (N. Lambert/ Gilhuys). Unanimously approved.

#### IX. New Business

- A. Restoration of Twin Peaks Road along Sonoran Moon & Marbella II Motion to recommend to the Board to accept the proposal from DLC Resources for installing 90 five-gallon plants (purple lantana & dwarf bottle brush) in the bullnoses of the Twin Peaks median between Coachline & Marbella II, and adding 50 five-gallon plants along the south side of Twin Peaks between Coachline & Marbella II, including irrigation adjustments NTE \$4,000 (N. Lambert/ Gilhuys). Unanimously approved.
- **B. Recurring Agave Pesticide Treatment** Committee requested topic be discussed at the February Landscape Committee meeting for semi-annual treatment.
- C. Completion of Hedge at Windmill Park Playground Motion to recommend to the Board to accept the proposal from DLC Resources for installing 5 five-gallon Xylosma shrubs to complete the Windmill Park playground hedge near the brick walkway, NTE \$120 (N. Lambert/ Gilhuys). Unanimously approved.
