I. Call to Order 6:30 P.M. at the Windmill Park Office

III. Approval of December 4, 2023, Meeting Agenda approved by motion (Lemieux/Stern).

- IV. Approval of November 6, 2023, Meeting Minutes approved by motion (Lemieux/Chamblee).
- V. Committee Chairperson Appointment: MOTION (Lemieux/Stern) to nominate Doug Childress as Chairperson for the 2023-2024 fiscal year; unanimously approved.

VI. Guests:

a. AAA Landscape: John Mancine, AAA Landscape Accounts Manager for CRCA, provided monthly status report; shared a 6-week rotation schedule with the committee for review; noted reduced watering schedules due to colder temperatures; and explained several ways rejuvenation pruning (cutbacks) could be done this winter.

MOTION (Childress/Stern) to approve removing one upright rosemary causing a sight obstruction in a median on Twin Peaks Road and Indian Summer Drive; unanimously approved.

- **VII. Board Actions:** No actions to report from the November 21st board meeting.
- VIII. Management Report: Ms. Boykin reported a contract credit was received from AAA Landscape due to reduced overseeding of turf areas this year; discussed irrigation repair expenses during the previous year compared to prior years; and noted a proposal request is still underway for the annual upper tree pruning job.

MOTION (Lemieux/Childress) to recommend the board consider amending the Reserve Study to put irrigation valve components on a separate schedule from the underground lines; unanimously approved.

IX. Homeowner Requests:

- a. Beautify Perimeter to The Loop (North of Twin Peaks Rd) After discussing the request, the committee did not want to make a recommendation to paint the perimeter walls but agreed to consider the area for decomposed granite in the future.
- b. Common Area Tree Causing Wall Damage: MOTION (Childress/Stern) to recommend that management request a proposal to install root barriers between the homeowner's wall and the (3) trees behind their property in CRCA common area; unanimously approved.

X. Unfinished Business:

- a. Silverbell/Coachline Entrance Turf Sprinkler Heads Replace Proposal: MOTION (Childress/Lemieux) to recommend to the board the proposal from AAA Landscape to replace all sprinkler heads in the turf of the Silverbell/Coachline monuments with stainless steel heads and of the same head type in each zone, NTE \$1,955.96 (Reserve funds); unanimously approved.
- b. Irrigation Controller Locks Proposal: MOTION (Childress/Lemieux) to recommend to the board the proposal from AAA Landscape to add locks to (18) irrigation controllers to reduce tampering, NTE \$1,526.50 (Operating funds); unanimously approved.

XI. New Business:

- a. 2024 Integrated Pest Management Program Renewal by AAA Landscape –
 Postponed to further evaluate the program's necessity.
- b. Irrigation Controllers 4G Upgrade Proposal: MOTION (Childress/Lemieux) to recommend to the board the proposal with rebate from AAA Landscape to upgrade the (21) 'smart' irrigation controllers from 3G to 4G so they can be brought online, NTE \$23,783.34 (Reserve funds); unanimously approved.
- c. Valve Replacements Proposals: MOTION (Childress/Stern) to recommend to the board the proposal from AAA Landscape to replace all remaining faulty irrigation valves throughout the property, NTE \$18,960.86 (Reserve funds); unanimously approved.
